The Youth Director will oversee growing and coordinating the WPC tweens and youth ministry and supporting programming for families and children by fulfilling the following:

- 1. Attend Sunday morning Sunday School hour and Church service

- 3. Develop and coordinate tweens and youth activities during the school year
- 4. Develop and coordinate at least one summer event for tweens and youth

- 6. Make face to face connections and develop positive relationships with children and families
- 7. Encourage outreach to additional youth in the community
- 8. Promote youth events and encourage attendance through social media and direct communication with tweens, youth, and parents. Encourage tweens and youth to invite friends to events

- 10. Assist with planning of holiday events to encourage involvement of tweens and youth.
