
# Hymn of the Month

### All My Hope on God is Founded

The hymn All My Hope on God Is Founded combines a timeless text of trust with one of the most moving modern hymn tunes ever written. The original German poem, Meine Hoffnung stehet feste, was written in the late 17th century by Joachim Neander—who also penned Praise to the Lord, the Almighty. In 1899, British poet Robert Bridges translated the text into English, crafting a version that balances poetic beauty with theological depth. Its words express an unwavering confidence that all earthly powers—wealth, pride, human strength—ultimately fade, while only God's goodness endures. The text's combination of humility and assurance makes it one of the most profound affirmations of faith in the hymn tradition.

The tune, MICHAEL, was composed in 1930 by English composer Herbert Howells. The story behind it is deeply personal: Howells originally wrote the tune for the Charterhouse School, where Bridges had once been a student, and later named it after his own son, Michael, who tragically died of polio at the age of nine. In naming the tune after his son, Howells transformed it into a musical act of remembrance—a melody of both grief and hope. Its soaring phrases and tender harmonies seem to carry that dual spirit, at once lament and trust. Every time the hymn is sung, it becomes not only an expression of faith in God's constancy but also a quiet testament to a father's enduring love.
